- IV. Conduct pre-feasibility study to strengthen the finalization of the Climate Smart Agriculture Concept Note.
- V. Finalize a Concept Note and corresponding Project Preparation Funding (PPF) application in conformity with the requirements of the GCF detailed in the GCF <u>Programming Manual</u> and in accordance with the Centre's accreditation to the GCF.
- VI. Conduct Project Development Training Workshops.
